*The Scholarship*

Danforth Scholars may receive full-or partial tuition scholarships, renewed each year for the duration of the degree program, provided the students progresses academically and upholds the high standards of character required of scholars.

The program is open to prospective graduate or undergraduate students applying to Washington University. Undergraduates **must be nominated to receive consideration**.

All students admitted to graduate study at Washington University will be automatically considered for a graduate Danforth Scholarship. This is a merit-based program, but need will be considered as part of the award process.

All application materials for admission must be submitted online or post marked by **November 1** for the students to be considered for scholarships valued up to \$ 36,000. #### **IU Excellence- \$36,000 (\$ 9,000 per year)**

The IU Excellence Scholarship is awarded to the brightest students in the State of Indiana who meet each of the following criteria:

- Indiana resident
- Minimum SAT score of 1340 or minimum ACT score of 30
- Minimum GPA of 3.80 on a 4.0 scale

#### **IU Prestige- \$16,000 (\$4,000 per year)**

The IU Prestige Scholarship is awarded to the student's who meet each of the following criteria:

- Indiana resident or out –of-state student
- Minimum SAT score of 1220 or minimum ACT score of 27
- Minimum GPA of 3.70 on a 4.0 scale

#### **Valedictorian Award- \$4,000 (\$1,000 per year)**

The valedictorian Award is awarded to students who meet each of the following criteria:

- Indiana resident
- Class rank of number one in your class at the time of admission.

**Indiana University Cox Research Scholarship (Non-automatic; student must apply separately)**
